# Private Swimming Pool Safety

Before the summer season begins, the City of Hampton reminds everyone to be safety conscious with their private swimming pools!

Hampton Municipal Code requires: Building permits for "in-ground" swimming pools and zoning permits for "above-ground" swimming pools with sidewalls exceeding 26" in height.

Permit applications can be found at www.hamptonia.us or at city hall. \*Swimming pools are not allowed in front driveways of properties

· Swimming pools shall be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition and in good repair. Pool water should be adequately treated often to ensure sanitary and safe swimming conditions. Swimming pools, if neglected can become a health hazard, resulting in insect-attracting, stagnant water.

• Pools under 24" in depth should be emptied when not in use to avoid unsupervised use as well as stagnant, dirty water.

 Steps or ladders should be removed to prevent access when pool is not being used.

· Pools should be covered when not in use to maintain cleanliness and avoid unintended access.

 Private swimming pool owners should check with their insurance carrier to ensure proper liability coverage for their swimming pools.

 Parents and guardians should be aware of their childrens' activities when near private swimming pools to protect them against swimming pool related accidents.

BEWARE!! 75% of pool related drownings happen to children 5 years and under.


